Taken and entered in the following order:— Commencing at Kings Acre, and on up to the Kington Road; then Veldivere Upper and Lower on the right, back again

to the remaining houses in Kings Acre, next Cherry Orchard, and across to part of Upper Breinton, then the Upper Hill, Springfield, Halfway House and part of Lower Breinton; next Warham and the rest of S. Breinton, followed by the remaining houses in Upper Breinton and finishing with Breinton Common and Sufemas Park.
