BREINTON CHURCHYARD 1992 - 1993.

In 1986 I started to record the headstones in Breinton Churchyard, first dividing the churchyard up into five sections, and making a map of each section, north, south, east, west and the 1948 extension on the northside of the Church and where the Garden of Rest and more recent graves are situated.

In 1878 part of the southside of the Churchyard was extended and consecrated by the Lord Bishop of Hereford the Right Reverend James Atlay. The 1948 extension was consecrated by Bishop K.G. Bevan, Bishop of Easton Szechwan, China. The Garden of Rest was dedicated by the Vicar of Breinton The Revd Bill Haynes September 1984.

Back to the recording, I had not finished all the headstones and in 1992 wanted to complete them, at least the older ones. I started off at number one the southside of the Church with my writing materials and my milking stool, with the help of the sun, wet headstones etc to write their inscriptions and roughly sketching them. (I wish I could draw) When I had completed the southside, it was much easier this time as one could get near to the headstones, back in 1986 the churchyard wasn't nearly so tidy. So on a few headstones I was able to add a few more words and others through flaking words had been lost.

The Family History Society asked for extra information, such as the conditions of the headstones and inscriptions etc, so back to number one! When I had completed the drawings and inscriptions, I then reduced my pages by 85%, then added the extra information on the left handside of the page. This I continued to do for the east, north, and west side.

The 1948 extension I will add in 1993, One thing I did not do was to write the inscription the same way as written on the headstone, I will do this when I record the headstones in the 1948 extension. I checked again and again the headstones, very easy to leave out one so this I have done and put the letter B after the number. New ones in the churchyard are lettered A, C etc after their numbers.

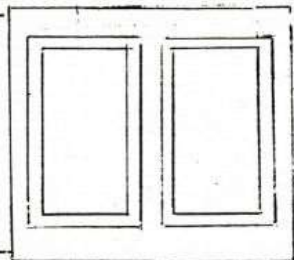

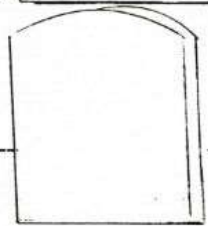
